Our 2019-2020 projects include:

Signature Project: Working together with community leaders and architects, JLP is leading a multi-year project, Vision for Julianne's Park. JLP will redesign and renovate one of Pelham's best parks.

Backpack Program: JLP provides 25 of the neediest families who attend the Boys & Girls Club of New Rochelle with totes full of healthy food to sustain them over a weekend on a bimonthly basis.

JLP Reads: In partnership with the Pelham Public Library and with a focus on promoting early literacy, members of this committee read at a children's story time twice a month. JLP is currently working to extend this initiative beyond Pelham with JLP Reads on the Road.

Professional Prep: This new addition to our project slate was founded with the intent to provide mentorship, networking opportunities and career development skills to adults and youth.

CSA Dinner Program: In partnership with Community Service Associates, JLP members purchase, prepare and/or deliver food for the dinner and take-home lunch programs at this Mount Vernon soup kitchen.

Pass it on Pelham: *JLP hosts collection drives for Pelham families to donate gently-used infant, children, and adult clothing and gear, then connects with local community organizations to those in-need.*

Toddlers in Science: Through this new initiative, JLP members visit local preschools and daycares to teach STEAM-oriented lessons to young students.

LovePelham.com: Committee members create and host a website of Pelham's non-profits and community organizations and their initiatives to better connect local residents with volunteer opportunities.

Pelham Public Art: In partnership with the Pelham Arts Center, JLP members create a unique art installation to enhance our community's beauty and creativity.

Done in a Day: This committee provides flexible volunteer opportunities for JLP members while assisting local organizations in need of volunteer support.
